KEY POINTS

ON THE STREET

- Most pedestrian and bicyclist deaths occur at night.
- I have to be 13 years old to ride in the front seat of a car.
- I have to be 16 years old with a license to operate an ATV.
- Temperatures become extremely hot inside a car and car trunk.
- In a car trunk, look for the emergency trunk release and pull it to escape.

• If a stranger gets you in a car, try to keep the car from starting, try to toss the keys or get out and run away.

AT THE PLAYGROUND

- A major injury risk at a playground is strangulation.
- In play areas, hard landing surfaces are dangerous.
- Protect yourself by wearing a helmet, wrist guards, knee pads and shoes while riding your bike.

AT THE POOL

- Learn to swim.
- Always swim with an adult watching you.
- Stay away from pool drains or suction outlets.

IN THE HOME

- A child playing with matches or lighters is the leading cause of home fires.
- Children should be supervised while cooking.
- Medicines, make-up, cleaners, and lotions can all become poisons if left in the reach of children.
